

Announcement Services - Overview

Purpose

Streamlines the Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) planning, creation, approval, and publication process

Create plans
to manage
upcoming funding
opportunities and
share with the
public as forecasted
opportunities on
Grants.gov.

Dynamically generate NOFO documents that use templates to blend boilerplate language with program-specific content.

Provide a collaborative space where all reviewers can provide input on the NOFO.

Make updates to the NOFO online while the system tracks and versions all changes.

Customize workflow to tailor who is required to provide electronic approval. Post to Grants.gov with just one click, and seamlessly proceed to the next phase of the grants process.

Document Integrity, Efficiencies

- FOA templates provided to reduce Author(s) efforts and ensure document quality
- Only one working copy of the FOA with custom editing limitations

Traceability, Transparency

- Automatic notifications and custom reminders
- Automated process that shows past, present and future stages

Data Quality, Data Analytics

- Seamless integration with Grants.gov and GMM
- Data shared across FOA document, reducing double-data entry
- BI Reporting



Compliance

OMB Guidelines

- FOA Templates comply with the OMB established standard document structure
- Admin users can easily implement OMB required changes with limited user interruption utilizing the Admin module
- System and exports are 508 compliant

Grants.gov Guidelines

- All Grants.gov required fields are marked required and validated well in advance of the Publication
- Grants.gov character and selection limitations are met within the system to prevent user frustration

Recent Enhancements



Directed Announcements

What it is:

- New configuration prompting users to select specific recipients that may apply to a NOFO
- Directed recipients are automatically notified via email upon publication to GMM

Why it's here:

- Streamlines and consolidates the process of creating directed announcements
- Saves time for both grantors and recipients with automated notifications
- One of our most frequently requested enhancements by partners!





NOFO Readability



What it is:

- Adds the ability for users to score the readability of their funding opportunities based on the Flesch Reading Ease and Flesch-Kincaid Grade Level evaluations
- NOFOs are to be graded prior to publication to Grants.gov

Why it's here:

- HHS initiative to write NOFOs in more plain language, derived from executive orders EO 13985 and EO 14091
- Goal is to make federal funding more accessible to traditionally underserved communities



NOFO Goals

What it is:

- Functionality to allow users to enter Funding Opportunity Goals into the FOA Content
- Goals will be sent to USASpending upon publication

Why it's here:

- Effective October 1, 2023, federal agencies must report Funding Opportunity Goals to USASpending for competitive grants and cooperative agreements
- Mandated by OMB Memo M-22-02
- Aim is to increase transparency of how federal dollars are spent
